## Andalucía, some indicators



Andalucía accounts for **18% of Spanish population** and about 13% of the national GDP








The agriculture sector represents 5% of the regional GDP

# Financial instruments in Andalucía



Andalucía has been pioneer in Spain (together with Cataluña) to implement financial instruments, having developed both JESSICA and JEREMIE in the 2007-2013 programming period

#### **JESSICA** Andalucía

- EUR 79,4m initial endowment
- EUR 79,4m (93%) final expenditure
- 9 projects and 784 job supported
- EUR 164m total investment supported
- 2.1 multiplier effect

#### JEREMIE Andalucía

- EUR 223,6m initial endowment
- EUR 170,4m (76%) final expenditure
- 164 projects and 14.105 job supported
- EUR 448m total investment supported
- 2.6 multiplier effect



# *fi-compass* targeted coaching



October 2017: Andalucía's MA benefitted from a **targeted coaching** session by *fi-compass* on FIs drawing upon RDP



- EC (DG AGRI) and EIB experts
- 2 days full immersion
- Latest regulation insights
- Practical cases



## *fi-compass,* feasibility study



Since February 2018 Andalucía's MA is receiving support from *ficompass* for a **feasibility study (free of charge) with a view to implement a financial instrument** drawing upon RDP resources



## Next steps



Depending on conclusions of the study and subject to decisions, there is an **interest** from Andalucía for a pilot FI in agriculture

Opportunities from Omnibus Regulation

**ESIF and EFSI** combination, **broader eligibility** than grants, **EU co-financing** rate, etc.

Solutions for the next MFF (less resources) FIs have a **revolving** (re-use of resources) and a **leverage** effect (attract more resources)

Need of a paradigm shift in the sector



Need to **reduce grant dependency** and to move towards more economically sustainable solutions








- Targeted coaching can be a powerful exercise
